2. Be conceived by a professional architectural or engineering firm or landscape designer.
3. Be installed by a professional fence contractor.

Criteria

Innovative design and installation of chain-link fence materials on a commercial, industrial, institutional, or sporting project

Entries will be accepted by mail or email.

Images should be provided in JPEG (.jpg) digital format. Digital images must not exceed a file size of 5MB.

Please note that Australian Chain-Link Fencing Association and Downee may contact winning entrant to obtain higher resolution images for inclusion in press release and magazine advertising. Australian Chain-Link Fencing Association and Downee reserve the right to showcase photography entries within their website as examples of entries.

Period

Entries open 1st January 2011 and close 15th August 2011.

Coverage

Judging
